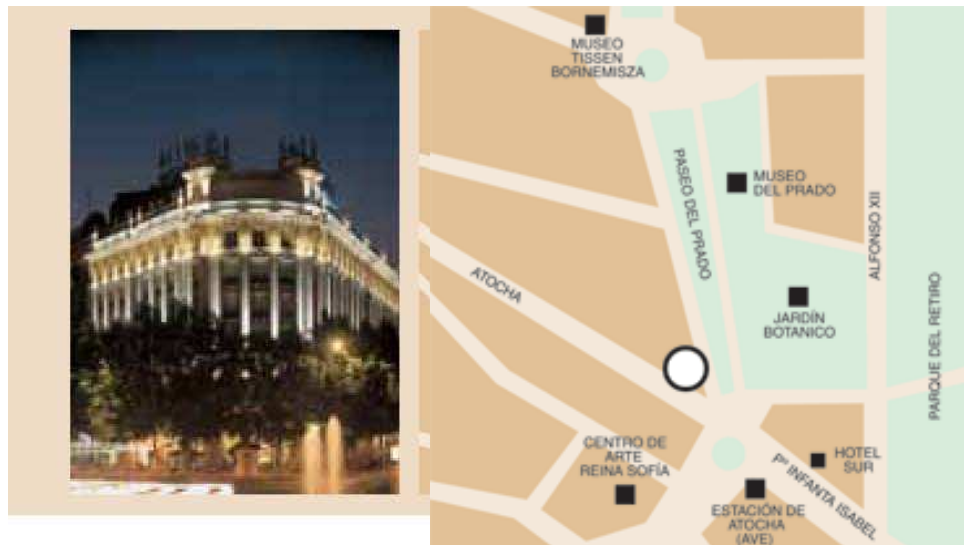

### ***By Metro from the Airport to the hotels in Madrid***

Follow signs to metro station Aeropuerto T1-T2-T3 or Aeropuerto T4. Take the line 8 till the terminus (Nuevos Ministerios). Change at the same station to Cercanias train (ask in Customer attention desk if help needed) and take a train (every 6 minutes) to Atocha train station. Agumar, Nacional and Carlton hotels are reachable in a short walk (5 minutes). Take a taxi to go to Vincci Hotel (about 1 Km far).
