

University of Konstanz

- Reform university, founded 1966
- 11.300 students
- 1860 staff
 - 210 professors
 - 840 non-academic
- Faculties:
 - Natural sciences
 - Humanities
 - Politics Law Economy



University of Konstanz




- Campus university
- Centrally organized Administration
- Budget:
 - Regular 114 Mio €
 - Third party funding 67 Mio €

Situation


- High voluntary engagement of students in sustainability projects
- No structural establishment of sustainability at the University
- Few lectures dealing with sustainability

Challenges

- Knowledge transfer (no central contact)
- Continuation of students involvement
- Transparency of activities for sustainability



Theses one
